Sub: Creation of one post of Principal, ten posts of Assistant Professor and five non-teaching posts and engagement of one Karmabandhu in Manikchak College, Dist.-Malda.

Sir,

I am directed by the order of the Governor to say that the Governor is hereby pleased to approve the creation of the following teaching and non-teaching posts in Manikchak College, Dist.-Malda. The details of the posts are as below:

(A) Teaching posts :

| Name of the Post | No. of the Post | Pay Band | Grade Pay |

| Principal | 1(One) | ₹ 37,400-67,000 | ₹ 10,000 |
| Assistant Professor (Two posts for each of the subjects, namely, Bengali, English, Political Science, History and Sanskrit) | 10(Ten) | ₹ 15,600-39,100 | ₹ 6,000 |

(B) Non-teaching posts:

| Name of the Post | No. of the Post | Pay Band | Grade Pay |

| Clerk | 2(Two) | ₹ 5,400-25,200 | ₹ 2,600 |
| Peon | 2(Two) | ₹ 4,900-16,200 | ₹ 1,700 |
| Guard | 1(One) | ₹ 4,900-16,200 | ₹ 1,700 |

(C) Engagement :

One Karmabandhu may be engaged on part-time basis at a consolidated monthly remuneration not exceeding ₹ 2,000/- to be paid out of contingency.

2. All the aforesaid posts will be filled up observing extant recruitment rules and reservation policy as applicable from time to time. The non-teaching posts sanctioned herein shall be filled up subject to the strict observance of the recruitment norms as stipulated in G.O. No. 585-Edn(CS) dated 09.09.2008. No further reference to this Department is required in the cases of newly created non-teaching posts if and if only the posts are filled up by the college authority within 1 (One) year from the date of issuance of this G.O., in terms of Finance Department's Memo No. 2555-F dated 02.04.2008.

3. The teaching posts sanctioned herein should be filled up with the recommendation of the West Bengal College Service Commission.

4. The charges on account of payment of salary of the staff of the College will be met from the head of account "2202-General Education-03-University and Higher Education-104-Assistance to Non-Govt. Colleges and Institutes-NP-Non Plan-001-Assistance to Non-Govt. Colleges and Institutes (EH)-V-31-Grants-in-aid-GENERAL-01-Salary Grants" in the current year's State Budget

5. This Order is issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide their U.O. No. Gr. P2/2015-2016/0229 dated 30.07.2015 and with the approval of the Cabinet in its meeting held on 18.12.2015 through their U.O. No. Cab(D)-2467 dated 28.12.2015.
