It is permanently affiliated to the University of Gour Banga and Recognized by University Grants Commission under section 2(f) and 12(B). Minimum Eligibility Criteria:

- a) Honours Programme: A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards / Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the Honours Programmes of Studies of B.A./B.Sc./B.Com./B.C.A. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.
- **b) General Programme:** A student who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent Examination from other Boards/Councils with at least four subjects having English as Compulsory Subject of 100 marks is eligible to take admission to the General Programmes of Studies of

B.A./B.Sc./B.Com. on the basis of merit and available vacancy of the particular subject(s) of the concerned college.

- c) A student who has passed Higher Secondary (10+2) examinations (with English as a subject) of the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development (Erstwhile West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training) or National or State Level Board in regular mode shall be eligible to take admission to the B.A./B.Com General Programme only.
- d) Students who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Examinations in the current year, immediate previous year and the year before the previous year will only be allowed to take admission.
- e) Aggregate marks shall be calculated by adding the marks in English and topthree subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate.
- f) The College authorities may fix higher eligibility criteria than the minimum eligibility criteria as laid down in point (a) & point (b)

Reservation of seats:

There shall be reservation of seats for SC / ST / OBC / Differently-abled Candidates as per Rules of the State Government.

Information Regarding Merit Point Calculation for Admission in UG Course/s for the Academic Session 2022-23:

(i) a) for Honours/Core Courses: (S+T)/4.

[Where S = Subject marks (opted for Honours/Core Course) and T = Marks obtained in English + marks of two other subjects (excluding EVS and the subject opted for Honours/Core Course)].

b) In case, any candidate opts for an Honours/Core Course beyond his/her subject combination [except linguistic subjects at H.S. (10+2) level], the merit point will be calculated as: $T_1/4$.

[Where T_1 = Marks obtained in English + best marks of three other subjects (excluding EVS and English)].

For General/Program Course the merit point calculation formula will be the same as (i) b) above
